

Service 51,31 and 30 is jointly subsidised by Dundee City Council and Angus Council and is operated by Moffat & Williamson.

Adult single fares are as follows:

Dykes of Gray to Asda - £1.60 Dykes of Gray to Ninewells - £2.10 Dykes of Gray to City Centre - £2.10

Return fares are also available.

The ABC (All Bus Companies) ticket is a multioperator ticket and can be used if you are likely to use other bus services in Dundee - e.g. a connecting service from Ninewells Hospital. The ABC day ticket costs £4.20 and weekly ticket costs £14.50. Ask the driver for an ABC smartcard to get started.

The bus services that operate between Dykes of Gray and Dundee will follow different routes at different times of the day. Some journeys will operate directly into Dundee and others will follow a more indirect route via Liff, Fowlis and Birkhill. This timetable has been created specifically for the Dykes of Gray community and is an abridged version of the full bus timetable which can be found on the Angus Council website.

All buses serving Dykes of Gray will arrive from the north (Liff direction). Buses will turn in from the Dykes of Gray Road at the Braes of Gray Road and will leave via Braes of Gray Place having served the bus stop at the Spar. Buses will then head back towards Liff and into Dundee.
