### **SUGGESTIONS AND COMMENTS RECEIVED IN RESPECT OF REVIEW**

Suggested items for Consideration:

- licensed premises that close for extended periods and the effect on the licence;
- the provision of free drinking water at events;
- maintaining the current policy terminal hours of premises.

### **Comments from Angus Licensing Forum joint meeting on 21 February 2023**

- (a) Suggestion that guidance for outdoor areas be included within the policy.
- (b) Suggestion that the terminal hour for outside areas be extended from 9pm to 10pm during the months of June, July and August.
- (c) Christmas Eve and Hogmanay – 6.9 (ii) of the policy - suggestion that the terminal hour for Christmas Eve and Hogmanay be 2am regardless of whether they fall on a weekday or weekend
- (d) Regards 6.4 of the policy (extended hours) – suggested no amendments required. If premises wish to apply for hours outwith policy these would be considered by the Board on a premises by premises basis.
- (e) Home delivery conditions should be included within the policy.
- (f) Discussion regarding how long a premises should remained closed and hold a licence. Should it be a maximum of 5 years or less. Forum members advising that sometimes it can take a long time to find another tenant and adequate time should be given.

### **Comment from Police Scotland**

“We however are keen for the terminal hour of premises to be adhered to as contained within the Angus Council Licensing Policy.”

**Comments from Janet Hood-**

“My clients are particularly concerned re under 18 conditions which are not clear on face of premises licences issued - at present only the policy numbers are on face of the licence and this makes it difficult to know exactly what is required.

The other matter is hours of nightclubs v pubs and the loss of differential during festive period etc”
