Statement of Reasons

for proposing to make the Angus Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading) (On-Street Parking) (Decriminalised Enforcement) (No. 7) Order 202x

Angus Council propose to introduce various new waiting restrictions and remove unnecessary restrictions on the lengths of roads listed below and as shown on the associated plans.

Police Scotland, elected members, residents and other members of the public have raised concerns over matters arising from inappropriate kerbside parking of vehicles. These include restricted drivers' visibility at junctions, restricted access to premises, general congestion, and congestion at or near school entrances.

The various requests or suggestions have been assessed by Roads officers in consultation with Police Scotland and in terms of the locations listed below it is considered that the introduction of waiting restrictions is appropriate for the reasons given and in the interest of pedestrian and traffic safety.

- introducing 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions to improve visibility and prevent obstructions at the following junctions:Brechin Road, East Muirlands Road, Grant Road (A92), Fisheracre (A92), Millfield Road, all Arbroath; Camus Street/Kinloch Street, Carnoustie; Turfbeg Road/North Loch Road Forfar; Dundee Road/Gardyne Street, Letham; Newhame Road, Montrose;
- introducing 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions to relieve congestion and maintain general access and free traffic flow in the following roads:-Arbirlot Road West, Mount Zion Brae, Elliot Street, Barngreen/Hamilton Green all Arbroath Tiger Beach Drive Carnoustie, Panmurefield Road Monifieth, Mill Lane Montrose.
- introducing 'Loading Only' bay, Monday Friday, 6.00am 8.30am at Ferry Street, **Montrose.**
- Introduce 'Loading Only' bay, Monday- Friday, 8.00am 6.00pm at East High Street, Forfar.
- removal of 'No waiting at any time' restriction at East High Street, Forfar.
