

## 5.1 | Triathlon Update – 21 May (Adam Wilson)

**Event date:** Sat 6<sup>th</sup> July 2024, Monikie Country Park

## Participant numbers:

- Adult Sprint Race: 130 places (of 200) taken, 0900hrs start
- Kids races 21 places (of 60) taken, 1200-1430hrs (road closure from Monikie hall, past primary school and left up to North Gate of Monikie, so as to protect children whilst cycling on that road
- Adult Relay: 6 teams (of 48) taken, 1430-1600hrs

**Parking**: Parking in Monikie park for participants, and some parking for volunteers. Parking secured at Monikie Primary School for participants. Parking provisionally secured at Monikie Hall for participants

**Road disruption**: No parking on Panmure road from Evening of Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July, to Evening of 6<sup>th</sup> July so as to ensure safety of cyclists and road users during competition. Road closure from Monikie hall to Monikie Primary, then left up to Monikie Park North Gate 1200-14300hrs for kids races to ensure their safety

**Local support/sponsorship**: Support secured from Strathmore Water, Erdinger Non-alcoholic beer and Angus Bike Chain. Support being sought from Byzantium, local Farmers and local businesses. <u>Any suggestions welcome</u>.

**Volunteer support:** Angus Canoe Club, Police Scotland Young Volunteers, Monifieth Triathlon Club, other local community groups. <u>Any other suggestions or willing volunteers, please contact me.</u>

**Community notification**: Plan for mail drop in local community first or second weekend of June 24. Plan to engage with farmers around Kirkton of Monikie, and place warning signs in area well in advance of event.
