THE ANGUS COUNCIL (EAST GRIMSBY, ARBROATH)(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that on 23 July 2024, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, so that junction realignment works may be undertaken.

The Order will come into force on 29 July 2024 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of 27 weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

- (1) The Order prohibits all vehicular traffic from driving and waiting on the following road or roads in Arbroath:-
 - (a) **East Grimsby (west lane)**; extending from its junction with Shore/Ladybridge Street in a northerly direction to its junction with Burnside Drive (A92), a distance of 70 metres or thereby.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic is via Ladbridge Street, Marketgate, Brothock Bridge and Burnside Drive (A92).

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

- (2) The Order prohibits pedestrian traffic on the following road or roads in Arbroath:-
 - (a) Burnside Drive (A92)(south side footway); extending from its junction with the west side footway of East Grimsby in a south-westerly direction to its junction with the north-east side footway of Fishmarket Quay, a distance of 120 metres or thereby.
 - (b) **East Grimsby (west side footway)**; extending from its junction with the north side footway of Shore in a northerly direction to its junction with the south side footway of Burnside Drive (A92), a distance of 70 metres or thereby.

The alternative route for pedestrian traffic is via Shore and Fishmarket Quay. The reverse route applies.
