ANGUS COUNCIL (THE SENIOR OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP, CARNOUSTIE) (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2024

Angus Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11(1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "Angus Council (The Senior Open Championship, Carnoustie) (Exemption) Order 2024" ("the Order") and shall come into effect at 05.00 hours on 24 July 2024 and will expire on 22:00 hours on 28 July 2024, unless revoked earlier.
- The effect of the Order is to exempt the area of ground outlined and hatched in red on the plan annexed hereto, comprising Carnoustie golf links, and areas to the east of Carnoustie Links Hotel including the black slab carpark and adjacent grassed areas, from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act.
- 3. The purposes for which the Order is made are:-
 - (a) to protect the safety and security of the Senior Open Championship; and
 - (b) to allow a charge for admission to the Senior Open Championship.
