Draft Angus Woodland Management Plans

The public consultation on the 8 draft woodland management plans on the online platform 'Engage Angus' returned 227 written responses and 86% of this number were received regarding the country parks at Monikie and Crombie.

We have reviewed all comments and actioned various amendments to the plans before they are submitted to <u>Scottish Forestry</u>. This agency will assess the plans and publish them on their <u>public register</u>, where stakeholders and interested parties can leave further comments as part of this consultation process.

With regards to the comments received for Monikie Country Park, many centred on the amount of clear felling at Pavilion and Denfind Woods and the reasons for the management proposals.

The need to undertake the felling works is due to the amount of windblown trees after storm Arwen and the risk of the remaining trees to be blown over in future events. To eliminate any danger to the public the works are concentrated on the affected zones, aiming to establish windfirm edges wherever feasible.

Felling plans have been amended to show the actual areas of proposed works. Only specific conifer species that are at risk will be removed, broadleaved trees and other coniferous species will remain in place.

For any proposed felling operations, appropriate replanting of the area will be a requirement of the felling permission application. As shown on the restocking maps all areas of felling will be replanted with suitable tree species, most of them native and some areas will be designed to attract red squirrels to those areas.

With any tree management works the relevant habitat and protected species legislation will be followed. Scoping surveys will be carried out prior to the works and suitable management activities will be identified in cooperation with relevant agencies and conservation groups, such as Tayside Bat Group, Scottish Badgers, Saving Scotland's Red Squirrels etc.

Community Feedback – Including FOMCP, AA to help with species scoping/surveys.
