The Community Council placed a wreath at the Commemorative Service on 11 November. The wreath was organised by Scott and placed by Duncan.

c) After-School Club

Parents from the Church and the School have started an after-school club for the children of Inverarity Primary School, running four nights a week. It takes place in the Church Hall. It is staffed by local volunteers and has been incredibly successful. It has taken many hours of planning and is a regular commitment by local parents to providing after-school care enabling parents to work and the children to have quality, supervised playtime with their friends. The community should be very proud of this initiative and is very grateful to the volunteers who have worked incredibly hard to set it up.

d) Riding for Disabled

The RDA ran a very successful end of season Christmas fair and open morning and awards ceremony in early December. The Community was also pleased to see a horse from the RDA taking part in the Remembrance Parage in Forfar and being featured in the Courier.

e) Pylons

To be discussed. Does the Community wish to apply for money from the SSE pylon fund? We are unsure if we are eligible as pylons do not pass over land that forms part of the Community Council constituency. Councillor Proctor felt that it would be worthwhile to look into potential funds, especially if there are local bodies (for example, Sunday School, After-School Club, RDA) who might benefit.
