### **Police Report**

Both officers present for this meeting Martin Brennan and Ronnie Irvine who represent our area (D division Tayside). Also the local area commander to join Angus.

They reported that our area is under review and that a new Chief Constable has been appointed, the first woman Chief Constable in Scotland.

May-June - quiet month 166 calls fall from last month, each month Carnoustie 15-17 crimes, crimes of dishonesty. Community garden has been vandalised - crime prevention strategies given. Both officers have recently been trained and can give training in survey and report when necessary (only 2 officers trained in D division are in Carnoustie). Emails have been sent to schools in area to prevent/warn of issues.

They have brought together housing officers in area to discuss anti social behaviour, and how they can help the area. They are also asking to know of problem tenants to help in area. Any concerns over CCTV then please email police and a document can be sent to you. Be careful of promoting on FB if you are a victim of crime - first response should be to report to police.
